ORIGINS



Lyndell A Glisson was born on November 6, 1921. According to our records [Mississippi](#) was her home or enlistment state and [Jones County](#) included within the archival record. We have [Laurel](#) listed as the city.

SERVICE



She had enlisted in the United States Army. Served during World War II. Glisson had the rank of Second Lieutenant. Her military occupation or specialty was Nurse. Attached to Army Nurse Corps, 172nd General Hospital.

CASUALTY



During her service in World War II, Army Second Lieutenant Glisson experienced a critical situation which ultimately resulted in loss of life on [March 4, 1945](#). **Recorded circumstances attributed to: DNB - Died Non-battle. Incident location: Ledo, India.**

DETAILS



She was killed along with other nurses in a C-47 transport with the 11th Combat Cargo Squadron that crashed near Ledo, India. All aboard were killed.

Lyndell A Glisson is buried or memorialized at Bezer Cemetery West, Bezer, Smith County, Mississippi.
