## ORIGINS



John Terry Gray was born on September 23, 1948. According to our records [Mississippi](#) was his home or enlistment state and [Jones County](#) included within the archival record. We have [Ellisville](#) listed as the city.

## SERVICE



He had enlisted in the United States Army. Entered the service via Regular Military. Served during the Vietnam War. He began his tour on June 18, 1968. Gray had the rank of Specialist Four. His military occupation or specialty was Light Weapons Infantry. Service number assignment was 67093058. Attached to 173rd Airborne Brigade, 3rd Battalion, 503rd Infantry, B Company.

## CASUALTY



During his service in the Vietnam War, Army Specialist Four Gray experienced a traumatic event which ultimately resulted in loss of life on [April 7, 1969](#). **Recorded circumstances attributed to: Died through hostile action, small arms fire.** **Incident location: South Vietnam, Lam Dong province.**

John is honored on the Vietnam Veteran's Memorial in Washington DC. Name inscribed at VVM Wall, Panel 27w, Line 30.
