Arthur Harmon was born on September 28, 1947.

SERVICE



He had enlisted in the United States Army. Entered the service via Regular Military. Served during the Vietnam War. He began his tour on June 2, 1968. Harmon had the rank of Private First Class. His military occupation or specialty was Light Weapons Infantry. Service number assignment was 12868283. Attached to 196th Light Infantry Brigade, 4th Battalion, 31st Infantry, D Company.

CASUALTY



During his service in the Vietnam War, Army Private First Class Harmon experienced a traumatic event which ultimately resulted in loss of life on [July 6, 1968](#).

Recorded circumstances attributed to: Died through hostile action, explosive device.

Incident location: South Vietnam, Quang Ngai province.

REMEMBERED

Arthur Harmon is buried or memorialized at Beaver Meadow Cemetery, Heidelberg, Mississippi.



Arthur is honored on the Vietnam Veteran's Memorial in Washington DC. Name inscribed at VVM Wall, Panel 53w, Line 26.
