He had enlisted in the United States Army. Served during the Korean War. Newell had the rank of Corporal. His military occupation or specialty was Light Weapons Infantryman. Service number assignment was 14274609. Attached to 24th Infantry Regiment, 25th Infantry Division.

#### CASUALTY



During his service in the Korean War, Army Corporal Newell experienced a traumatic event which ultimately resulted in loss of life on [October 8, 1950](#). **Recorded circumstances attributed to: Killed in Action. Incident location: South Korea.**
