SERVICE



He had enlisted in the United States Army. Served during the Korean War. Register had the rank of Corporal. His military occupation or specialty was Light Weapons Infantryman. Service number assignment was 14300940. Attached to 38th Infantry Regiment, 2nd Infantry Division.

CASUALTY



During his service in the Korean War, Army Corporal Register experienced a traumatic event which ultimately resulted in loss of life on [July 26, 1951](#). **Recorded circumstances attributed to: Killed in Action. Incident location: North Korea.**
