SERVICE



He had enlisted in the United States Army. Served during the Korean War. Robertson had the rank of Corporal. His military occupation or specialty was Intelligence NCO. Service number assignment was 14320304. Attached to 528th Military Intelligence Platoon.

CASUALTY



During his service in the Korean War, Army Corporal Robertson experienced a traumatic event which ultimately resulted in loss of life on [September 23, 1950](#). **Recorded circumstances attributed to: Killed in Action. Incident location: South Korea.**

DETAILS



Corporal Robertson was a member of the 528th Military Intelligence Platoon. He was Killed in Action while fighting the enemy in South Korea on September 23, 1950.

Vernon is remembered at the Korean War Veterans Memorial in Washington. This is a National Parks Service and American Battle Monuments Commission location.
